MISSION NEWS Mission Spot. MAF

In South Sudan there has been a 3-day Healing Hearts Workshop led by MAF's Team Leader Thomas Titus about trying to address intertribal conflict at a personal level. In this way they are trying to get past hurts and revenge culture replaced by forgiveness.

South Sudanese evangelist Raphael Joel says "We thank God for the workshops which is the best way of bringing communities together and to live peacefully. This training has nothing to do with politics, it is just about God working in the hearts of people and touching them as individuals. Some of the training was not easy even for me to see the whole community as one tribe. It has taught me as a Christian we must be united in diversity. The training changed the way I think. God can do something wonderful in every community in South Sudan",

Please pray that peace, healing and forgiveness will come amongst the various tribes in South Sudan.
