“Something amazing is happening in Egypt. Something you would love to hear about. There is a revolution in Egypt’s Churches. Young people are flocking to Church. Faith is growing. God is at work”.

People in Egypt are longing for Bibles to read and study but they can’t afford to buy one because Egypt is in economic crisis, The Bible Society has provided thousands of Bibles to Egypt but there are never enough. A pastor told the Bible Society that 2,400 Bibles had been given out in one day, but they could have given out 7000 that day. Thousands went home empty handed.

Amir who leads Bible Ministry in Egypt believes support for Bibles can transform the nation of Egypt. His dream is to place a Bible into every home. In this Muslim majority country, even non-Christians are asking for Scriptures.
